## MEN'S INTER-CLUB COMPETITION - RULES

The Parks Circle and the Private Clubs each have their own competitions, ie the Parren / Beharrel and the Cutler shield. To promote greater playing contact, a knockout competition between the Association Clubs will be run each year by the Southend & District Bowling Association.

- 1) Each club to provide ONE TEAM of unbadged outdoor players, to compete as a Singles, Pairs, Triples, Fours, & Two Wood Singles of 21 Ends.
- 2) Every competitor shall be unbadged on the 30<sup>th</sup> April in each year of the competition.
- 3) The minimum age for competitors is sixteen.
- 4) A substitute may be used in any of the Singles, Pairs, Triples and Fours competitions.
- 5) **Two (2) points awarded for a win. If any of the 5 games end as a draw, an extra end must be played to get a result.**
- 6) Results of the match to be telephoned to the Competition Secretary on 01702-906558. Email [competitionsecretary@southendanddistrictba.co.uk](mailto:competitionsecretary@southendanddistrictba.co.uk) Immediately on completion, and the score cards posted or emailed, or text.
- 7) The Competition Fee will be £15 per team; Club Secretaries shall send their Competition Entries and fees to the Competition Secretary, not later than 26th June. All entries should give a name, email address and telephone number of the club's contact.
- 8) All games to be played on the green of the challenger; Semi-finals to be played on a neutral green.
- 9) The final will be played at Essex County Bowling Club on Sunday, 12th September, 2021
- 10) The rounds of the competition will be played on or before the designated dates during the last three months of the playing season.
- 11) The Club appearing first in each round of the draw shall be the challenger, and by direct contact offer the opposing Club Two dates; dates offered must be different days of the week, and include one weekend date.
- 12) A round may be played on a different day, subject to an agreement of both parties, and providing the Competition Secretary is informed.  
Any match so arranged should start no later than 5pm.
- 13) Any team who plays a round with less than 11 players, will be penalised 2 points.
- 14) Dress – All rounds, including the Semi-finals to be played in Greys, Finals to be played in Whites, with Club Shirts.
